Management's Responsibility for Financial Reporting


Blood Tribe management is responsible for the preparation, accuracy, objectivity, and integrity of the accompanying schedule of remuneration and expenses for Chief and Council, including responsibility for significant accounting judgments and estimates in accordance with the First Nations Financial Transparency Act. This responsibility includes selecting appropriate accounting principles and methods, and making decisions affecting measurement of transactions in which objective judgment is required.

In fulfilling its responsibilities and recognizing the limits inherent in all systems, management has designed and maintained a system of internal controls to produce reliable information to meet reporting requirements. The system is designed to provide management with reasonable assurance that transactions are properly authorized, reliable financial records are maintained, and assets are properly accounted for and safeguarded.

Chief and Council are composed entirely of individuals who are neither management nor employees of the Blood Tribe. The Council is responsible for overseeing management in the performance of its financial reporting responsibilities, and for approving the financial information included in the annual report. The Council fulfill these responsibilities by reviewing the financial information prepared by management and discussing relevant matters with management and external accountants. The Council is also responsible for recommending the appointment of the Blood Tribe's external accountants.

The schedule of remuneration and expenses of Chief and Council have been reviewed by the independent firm of KPMG LLP, Chartered Professional Accountants. Their report to Chief and Council and the Members of the Blood Tribe, stating the scope of their examination and opinion on the financial statements, follows.

INDEPENDENT PRACTITIONERS' REVIEW ENGAGEMENT REPORT

To Chief and Council of the Blood Tribe

We have reviewed the accompanying schedule for the remuneration and expenses of Chief and Council for the year ended March 31, 2022. The schedule has been prepared by management in accordance with the First Nations Financial Transparency Act.

Management's Responsibility for the schedule of remuneration of Chief and Council

Management is responsible for the preparation of the schedule of remuneration and expenses of Chief and Council in accordance with the First Nations Financial Transparency Act, and for such internal control as management determines is necessary to enable the preparation of the schedule that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Practitioners' Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the accompanying schedule based on our review. We conducted our review in accordance with Canadian generally accepted standards for review engagements, which require us to comply with relevant ethical requirements.

A review of the schedule in accordance with Canadian generally accepted standards for review engagements is a limited assurance engagement. The practitioner performs procedure, primarily consisting of making inquiries of management and others within the entity, as appropriate, and applying analytical procedures, and evaluates the evidence obtained.

The procedures performed in a review are substantially less in extent than, and vary in nature from, those performed in an audit conducted in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion on this schedule.

Based on our review, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the schedule of remuneration and expenses of Chief and Council for the year ended March 31, 2022 is not prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the First Nations Financial Transparency Act.
